HARMONY WORKS TRUST SECURES £8.5M IN FUNDING FOR NEW HUB FOR MUSIC EDUCATION

We are delighted to share exciting news: the Harmony Works Trust has secured an incredible £8.5m million in funding from Arts Council England, through the Department for Culture, Media and Sport Development Fund and the National Lottery Heritage fund. This funding will help transform the historic Canada House in Sheffield City Centre into a dynamic new hub for music education—our future home! We've still got just short of £3m to raise and this year we will be working hard to source the remaining funding – if you can help please do get in touch!



SHEFFIELD MUSIC HUB REBRAND!

In 2024 the Department for Education restructured Music Hubs nationally and asked us to form strategic regional Music Hubs. In September we joined together in a consortium with our partners from the region to form the South Yorkshire Music Hub, led by our combined Mayoral Authority (SYMCA). The regional work supports strategic development, training and high-profile opportunities. Locally delivery will remain the same. Therefore the delivery aspect of Sheffield Music Hub, i.e. the music lessons and music groups (the stuff you're seeing and hearing tonight) needs a new name as we move forward.
